

PE and sports premium report

The school was funded with a PE and sports premium of £11,500 for year 2013/14.

Changes in approach for 2014/15

The school is not proposing to use this funding to continue professional development training for gymnastics and dance, but divert the spending to provide additional support for teachers delivering games sessions. This will operate in a similar way to the previous year, but using a sports coach rather than an additional teacher. The spending on sports skills will continue and there will be an additional spend to provide access to swimming opportunities for all Year 5 and 6 pupils.
