

## Pupil premium report

The school was initially funded with a pupil premium of £18,900 for year 2013/14, however this rose to £30,496 at the start of the academic year.

**Changes in approach for 2014/15**

The school is not proposing to use its pupil premium funding in a very different way in 2014/15 to last year, however there will be a greater level of spend to provide TA support for targeted pupils both within lessons and in booster sessions. There will also be a slightly greater spend on the support of school trips, nurture groups and some support for families to provide school uniform.
