## **Special Needs Community Information Point (SCIP)**

This is a database for children and young people aged 0-19 years who have special needs or a disability and their families in Cambridgeshire. Through SCIP you will receive:

- Information on services, activities & support
- News and events
- Support network – request information specific to your family's needs via telephone or email
- The SCIP card – produced for families who on occasion need assistance while out with their child, especially where the condition is not visibly evident, or when a child is likely to react to a situation such as loud noises
- The Carers Magazine and Support directory
